## I. POLICY

- A. Guidelines for Memorial/Graveside service recognition for deceased Public Safety members.
  - 1. Initiate agency warning tone;
  - 2. Dispatcher shall announce on the primary fire and EMS paging frequency: "Attention all Fire and EMS personnel; In recognition for many years of dedicated service to the Franklin County Department of Public Safety and (<u>Station Name</u>), and the citizens of Franklin County by (<u>name of deceased member</u>). The County of Franklin respectfully salutes our departed comrade with this personal and final call"
  - 3. Initiate station alert tone (insert proper tone keys here) times in succession.

## B. Tone Keys.

1. <u>One tone salute</u>:

Less than 10 years service.

Two tone salute:

10 - 20 years service.

Three tone salute:

Greater than 20 years service, charter member, lifetime

members, inactive or past line officer including

Chief/Captain.

Four tone salute:

Active line officer other than Chief/Captain.

Five tone salute:

Active Chief/Captain, Active or past Director or Deputy

Director Public Safety.
